Proposals for enhanced dissemination of **Kimilsungism-Kimjongilism**
in Africa 2014 - 2015

Having held wonderful discussions with Dr. Ogami Kenichi, Secretary General of IJJI, and Mr. Pak, KASS executive secretary for Africa, the Directors, Secretary General and Director General drew out a proposal for enhanced activities for dissemination of Juche Idea in Africa.

A four (4) point programme has been proposed;

1. The Director General is to set up a functional bureau/office in Kampala which will be coordinating with other country Directors on a full time basis. The Secretary General working closely with the Director General of ARCSJI shall be sending out standard guidelines to all country Juche Study Groups.
2. The guidelines will, among other issues, cover the need to have national seminars and meetings at least 2 times a year. And for smaller Juche Chapters to always meet at least once a month. The national committees would also be encouraged to always observe some of the important holidays in respect of the

leaders, President Kim Il Sung, General Kim Jong Il and Marshal **Kim Jong Un.**

3. A central web-page shall immediately be opened in Kampala to receive postings of the country-web-sites and be linked to the IIJI web-site. A bi-annual ARCSJI magazine shall be published and will always come out before the bi-annual meetings of the Board of Directors of ARCSJI. The Director General shall manage the editing of the publication office with the Secretary General. Articles shall cover solidarity messages, academic papers and chapter activities.
4. Preparations to hold the 10th Board of Directors meeting and a seminar are to begin. At this meeting the Secretary General IIJI, Dr. Ogami Kenichi may attend.

Proposed venues are;

Kinshasa DRC, Conakry Guinea, South Africa, Addis-Ababa Ethiopia, Equatorial Guinea and Benin.

Final Decision shall be taken depending on the suitability of the country in terms of political stability, support by the local/national committee and confirmation by KASS.

Proposed dates are mid-May 2015.

Efforts must be made to revive the, Juche Chapters in Madagascar, Brazzaville Congo, Senegal, Mali, Ghana, Zambia, Angola, and Morocco. The Secretary General to closely work with KASS to ensure that the old contacts are activated.
