

STATUTE OF THE INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE OF THE JUCHE IDEA

Article 1. This organization is called the International Institute of the Juche Idea (IIJI).

Article 2. The IIJI is the international organization of academic research and dissemination of the Juche idea.

Article 3. The IIJI has its mission to study and disseminate the Juche idea.

Item 2. The IIJI collects information, assists and encourages academic and theoretical activities for the study, dissemination and application of the Juche idea conducted by regional institutes and national organizations for the study of the Juche idea.

Article 4. According to its nature and duty, the IIJI conducts activities.

1. to disseminate the classical works of President Kim Il Sung, General Secretary Kim Jong Il and Leader Kim Jong Un.
2. to arrange seminars and lecture meetings on the Juche idea.
3. to publish academic magazine "Study of the Juche Idea" more than once a year, "Newsletter of the Secretariat of the IIJI" more than once in three months and other necessary publications.
4. to make academic cooperation and exchange experience for the activities to study, disseminate and apply the Juche idea conducted in different countries over the world.
5. to open and manage internet homepage on the Juche idea.

Article 5. The IIJI keeps contacts with the organizations and individuals in different countries who are interested in the Juche idea.

Item 2. The IIJI can organize its member organizations in different countries and continents.

Article 6. The leadership body of the IIJI is the Board of Directors.

Item 2. The Board of Directors consists of director-general, deputy directors-general, secretary-general and directors.

- 1) 1 Director-General
- 2) Not less than 2 deputy directors-general
- 3) 1 Secretary-General
- 4) Not less than 4 directors in each continent; Asia, Africa, Latin America and Europe
- 5) 1 member from the KASS
- 6) 1 member from the General Association of the Korean Residents in
- 7) Japan.

Item 3. The Board of Directors' Meeting is called by the director-general every three years. And interim meeting can be called when more than two thirds of directors request to call the meeting.

Item 4. The Board of Directors' Meeting discusses and decides all the important activities of the IIJI and elects director-general, deputy directors-general, and directors and decides honorary director-general and honorary deputy directors-general.

Item 5. The term of director-general, deputy directors-general and directors is three years and they can be re-elected after their term is expired.

Item 6. The Board of Directors' Meeting awards honorary title to those directors who made special merits in their activities to study and disseminate the Juche idea after their term is over.

Article 7. The directors of the IJJI Board are elected when they satisfy the following conditions.

1) Those who have social influence.

2) Those who are active in the given organization for more than two years.

3) Those who are recommended by the regional institute

Item 2. Director is elected in the Board of Directors' Meeting.

Item 3. In principle, no more than 2 persons from each country are elected directors.

Item 4. The directors should keep in contacts with the IJJI and inform of their activities regularly.

Article 8. The IJJI has the regional institutes in each continent.

Item 2. The IJJI keeps in contacts and cooperates with the regional institutes for the active and constructive study and dissemination of the Juche idea in each continent.

Item 3. The IJJI cooperates with the regional institutes III electing the directors with social influence and ability.

Item 4. The IJJI keeps in close contacts with the regional institutes and collects the information of the study and dissemination of the Juche idea in each region.

Item 5. The IIJI helps and cooperates with the Juche idea study organizations in different countries so that they can strike the root in their countries and enjoy support from the broad masses.

Article 9. The executive body of the IIJI is the Secretariat.

Item 2. The secretariat performs its regular activities of the IIJI according to this statute and the decision of the Board of Directors.

Item 3. The secretariat consists of the Secretary-General and a few members.

Item 4. The secretary-general is appointed by the Director-General and the members of the secretariat are appointed by the secretary-general.

Article 10. The IIJI is funded by donations of the organizations and individuals who support the Juche idea and by the income of the IIJI

Item 2. The friendship organizations with the Democratic People's Republic of Korea are included in the Juche idea study organization in the broad sense.

Item 3. The study organizations in different countries shall strike its roots deeply among the people and act well so that it can enjoy support of the broad masses.

Item 4. The study organizations in different countries have to regularly inform the regional institute of their activities in close contact with it.

Article 11. The headquarters of the IIJI is in Tokyo, Japan.

Article 12. This statute can be revised and supplemented in the Board of Directors.

This statute comes into force since April 13, 2014.
